Another stop on the tour is St. Elizabeth, the “bread basket” of Jamaica, which supplies a variety of produce through increasingly greenhouse farming initiatives and where guests will have the opportunity to explore the area and learn the captivating history of the community. “Lovers Leap” is the next site and offers a spectacular view of the Caribbean and a fascinating story behind its name. The last stop includes a walk through Southfield and Top Hill and will bring guests and locals together during an afternoon spent in the home of one of Jamaica’s famous Bankers, Aubyn Hill, an entrepreneur and a budding farmer, before returning to Montego Bay.
